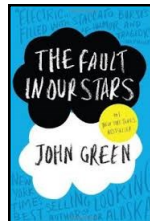

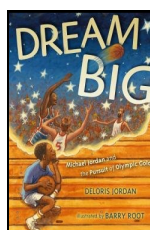
#### *The Broken* by Tamar Cohen

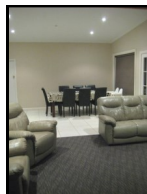
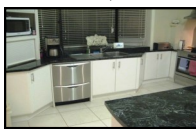
