## Secret Rocks

On the 27<sup>th</sup> of August the Yr 7 and 8 classes went on an excursion to Secret Rocks. There we met John Read who is an ecologist, he spoke about his land and his job. He gave Lila, Katarina and Tahlia a quoll tracker and told them to hide. We searched for them using an antenna which linked to the collar through a satellite but it wouldn't work and we lost the girls for a while (well they knew where they were but we didn't). We had a sausage sizzle for lunch. After that John took us for a walk to see the effects of burning and feral animals on the land. He told us that if native scrubland is burnt regularly it regenerates really well and we saw an example of that. John showed us a spy camera and a chalky wattle which is an endangered species. We then drove to a different location and saw an old Mallee Fowl nest. John talked to us about Mallee Fowl behaviour and survival. We were put into groups and had a competition on who could build the best Mallee Fowl nest in the best location. After that we said goodbye and gave John a gift for his hospitality and went back to school.

Thankyou to John for his time, Mr Kirby for driving the bus, Mr Peters for cooking lunch and Mrs McFarlane and Mrs Peters for organising the day.


